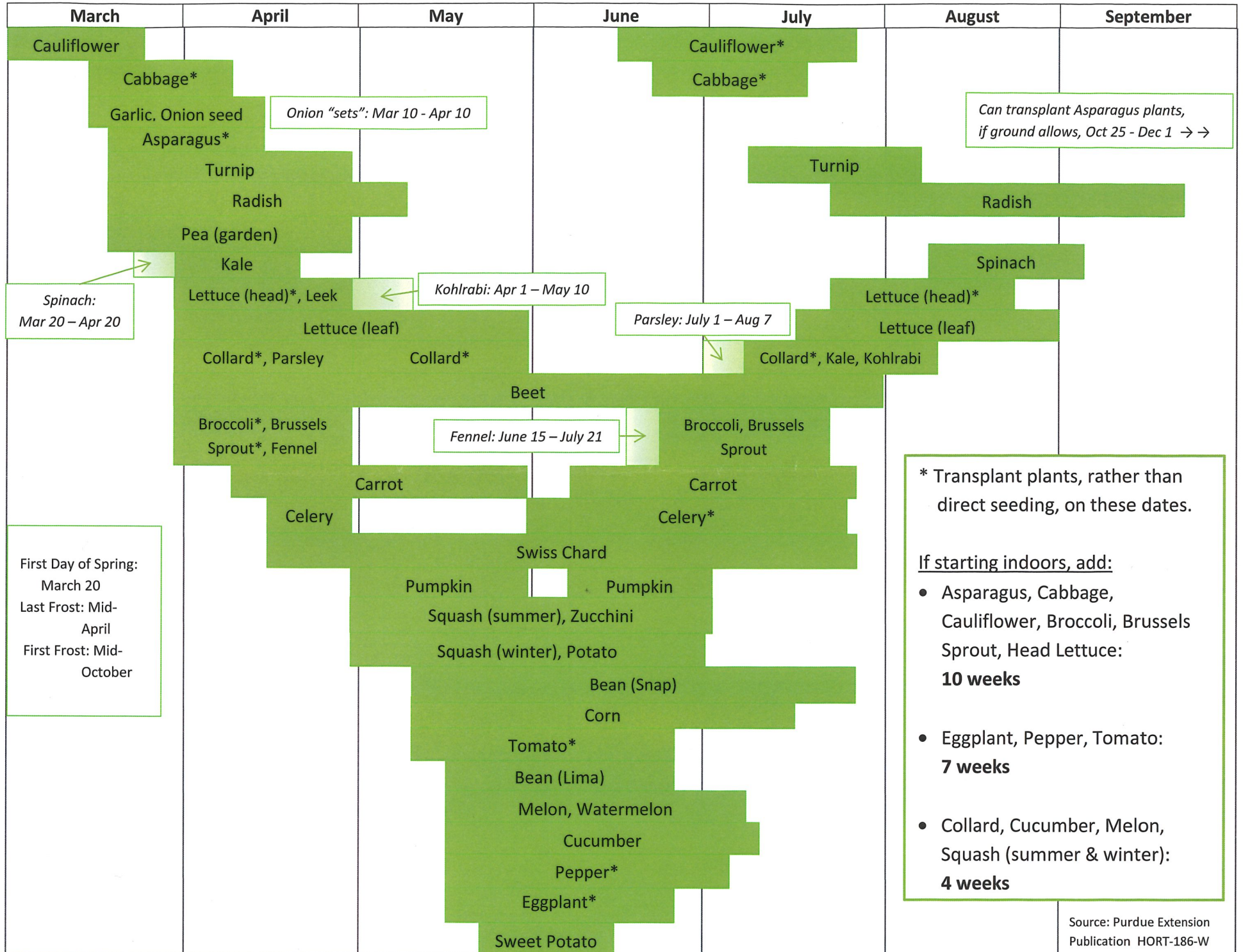
Join us and bring seeds to exchange if you have them, or just come and learn more about seed saving. Hear from local growers and other guest speakers as they share stories and seed saving tips.






SEED LIBRARY

The Seed Library

is a collection of open-pollinated and heirloom seeds that any resident of Hamilton County with a valid library card from his or her home library can borrow to plant at home.



Seeds are available to "check out" from **March 4th through October**. Each person may check out up to **5 packets per visit**, to a total of **15 packets per season**.

At the end of the growing season, borrowers are encouraged to save seeds to return to the library and/or keep for their garden next year. The Seed Library will only accept open-pollinated seeds that are self-pollinated.

The Seed Library is located next to the check-out desk on the first floor in a cabinet that looks like an old card catalog.
