

SEED LIBRARY

The Seed Library

is a collection of open-pollinated and heirloom seeds that any resident of Hamilton County with a valid library card from his or her home library can borrow to plant at home.

Seeds are available to "check out" from **March 4th through October**. Each person may check out up to **5 packets per visit**, to a total of **15 packets per season**.

At the end of the growing season, borrowers are encouraged to save seeds to return to the library and/or keep for their garden next year. The Seed Library will only accept open-pollinated seeds that are self-pollinated.

The Seed Library is located next to the check-out desk on the first floor in a cabinet that looks like an old card catalog.



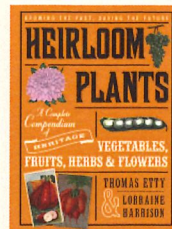
